

Cell Phone Audio Jammer(4 slots) AJB-336 User Guide



Introduction

AJB-336 is a 4-slot cell phone audio jammer positioned for small conference rooms, reception rooms, negotiation rooms and other scenes. AJB-336 can accommodate up to 4 cell phones at the same time, and achieve the effect of jamming for each phone.



Power ≤ 5%: power indicator light flashes rapidly Power < 1%: buzzer sounds 3 times, ambient light flashes 3 times, jamming and ambient light off.



How to Use



Notes

- 1. Do not use power supplies, chargers or batteries other than those originally supplied to power the jammer.
- 2. Do not place the jammer in operation close to or directly in front of your ear.
- 3. Do not expose the jammer to dusty, humid environments for a long time.
- 4. Do not use liquid solvents to clean the jammer, use a dry cloth to gently wipe the surface dirt and dust.
- 5. Do not place the jammer in a place with extremely high or low temperature, the storage environment is -10°C $\sim 45^{\circ}\text{C}$, otherwise it will affect the service life of the device.
- 6. Do not expose the jammer to high temperatures or around heat generating devices, such as sunlight, heaters, microwave ovens, ovens or water heaters.
- 7. When the device is not in use, you should charge it once every month, and the battery charge should not be less than 80% of the total power.
- 8. Do not drop, squeeze or puncture the jammer as this may cause it to work abnormally or be damaged.
- 9. Do not disassemble the jammer.
